The facility boasts comfortable new seating, kiosk and ticket selling area as well as new decoration throughout. The projection equipment has also been upgraded allowing films to be shown in both traditional 35mm print format and in the new digital format all with full surround sound.

The upgraded kiosk offers freshly made popcorn, ground coffee and a variety of other sweets, refreshments and, of course, house made choc-tops.

The Cinema has a seating capacity of 121 and there is excellent access for wheelchair users. A hearing loop is also available in all parts of the Cinema.
