At the foot of Mount Sturgeon, the southern tip of the Grampians and the Great Dividing Range you will find the booming little town of Dunkeld. Named after a town in the Scottish Grampians, Dunkeld has enjoyed a stellar revival in the last 15 years.

The attraction to Dunkeld is instant, the well kept main street is dotted with shops, the stand-out feature being the Royal Mail Hotel where linen-lined tables serve gourmet meals as well as high quality pub fare. Gourmet Traveller magazine voted its wine list as the best in Australia. The huge list includes local wines from the Henty, Grampians and Pyrenees wineries.

Dunkeld is well and truly on the tourist map now as the starting point for many who look to spend time in the Grampians, but Dunkeld has many highlights of its own.

You will find an Arboretum at the end of a pleasant walk along the small creek through the town. This

well-loved sanctuary has been cleverly planned, the walking track meanders past hundreds of trees including many giant red gums. Central to the area is a series of small lakes that are crossed by several bridges. It is a walk that will take you on both a physical and mental journey. What could be better than watching the end of the day from the small pier with a stunning view of Mount Abrupt, alight in the red glow of sunset.

For the more vigorous visitor, a hike up Mount Sturgeon, Mount Abrupt or the Piccaninny gives the visitor a great view of the entire Southern Grampians range.

The history of this fascinating district is well presented and documented at the Dunkeld Museum, the directions for which you will find at the Visitor Information Centre, a must visit to anyone coming to Dunkeld.

A view into the rich pastoral heritage of the area can be found at Mount Sturgeon Station just to the west of Dunkeld at the very base of the mountain. The bluestone cottages have been specially fitted out for those wanting to stay a little longer in luxury, whilst the enormous and well restored shearing shed still feels like it would have back in the days when the station comprised of 40,000 acres.

Dunkeld is quite simply spoilt with accommodation options. From the Community Caravan Park to the ultra-modern Eco-Lodges, traditional Bed and Breakfast to log cabins. It is no wonder more people are choosing to stay in Dunkeld as a base for a Grampians adventure.

Dunkeld hosts various events throughout the year, the most famous being the Dunkeld races, held annually in November on the second Saturday after the Melbourne cup. Join Dunkeld's gardeners and artists on the first weekend of every month as they open their gardens and galleries for visitors to

explore. Workshops, tours and exhibitions are often a feature of the weekend. Held annually in October the Discover Dunkeld - "a mosaic of experiences" weekend has something for all.

Visiting Dunkeld gives you the opportunity to enjoy the local produce of the area. Grampians Pure sheep dairy produces a variety of yoghurt and cheese. The sheep are milked daily and visitors are welcome to view the process. Artwork of the local region is featured at the Sandra Kranz Art Studio, Waiting Room Art Gallery, Off the Rails Gallery, Ros McArthur Art Studio, Cloud Mountain Retreat & Gallery and local eateries.

The village of Dunkeld provides a natural peaceful setting for those seeking a more contemplative experience. Both the Cloud Mountain Retreat and Griffins Hill Retreat offer time and space to do just that. Relax with a session of Iyengar Yoga or get in touch with your inner self through meditation and reflective sessions.
